Razom endorses Speaker Johnson's Ukraine bill

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Razom for Ukraine, a U.S. nonprofit providing medical and humanitarian aid to Ukraine and the top advocate for continued U.S. assistance to Ukraine, released the following statement on Speaker of the House Mike Johnson's Ukraine bill. The statement is attributable to Mykola Murskyj, Director of Advocacy at Razom.

"Today, Speaker Johnson unveiled the text of a new version of supplemental aid to Ukraine, and we were pleased to see that, if passed, it would deliver life-saving assistance to Ukraine at the most critical moment of the war since February 24, 2022. Razom for Ukraine endorses this legislation and urges the House to pass it as soon as possible.

"We will continue to watch for the text of other Ukraine-related components in separate legislation, such as the REPO Act and a potential new Lend-Lease authority for Ukraine. As long as the 'innovations' do not undermine the ability of the United States to quickly provide assistance to Ukraine in support of its victory, that bill will receive our support as well.

"Our message to the House today is simple—vote yes. Ukraine doesn't have time for Congress to waste. The Senate must be prepared to immediately take up and pass aid to Ukraine."
